

Code of conduct

Wadebridge Coasters Cycling Club (WCCC)

WCCC is fully committed to safeguarding and promoting the well-being of all its members, ensuring a positive and enjoyable experience for all. The club believes that it is important that all club members should, at all times, show respect and understanding for the safety and welfare of others. Therefore, members are encouraged to be open at all times and to share any concerns or complaints they may have about any aspect of the club with **any committee member**.

As a member of WCCC, you are expected to abide by the following code of practice:

- All members must take responsibility in ensuring they are up to date with, understand, and abide by the [club etiquette](#), which is published on the club website.
- All members must respect the rights, dignity and worth of all participants regardless of age, gender, ability, race, cultural background, religious beliefs or sexual identity.
- Members should recognise the valuable contribution made by the club committee who are all volunteers. They give their time and resources to provide cycling opportunities for us all.
- All members must respect club committee members and publicly accept their decisions.
- All members should behave in a positive manner and act as a role model for WCCC, treat other cyclists, pedestrians and motorists with the same level of respect expected in return, and be generally courteous to all other road users.
- Use correct and proper language at all times.
- Members are not allowed to smoke, consume alcohol or drugs whilst riding with or representing the club during rides.
- Members should keep to agreed timings for club rides and events, or inform a ride leader or event organiser if they are going to be late or are leaving the ride part way through.
- Members must wear safe, suitable and appropriate kit when on club rides.
Helmets must be worn at all times.
- Members must pay club membership fees and fees for events promptly when these are requested.
- Bullying of any sort will not be tolerated.
- Encourage everyone to enjoy cycling and understand that people have different motivations for taking part.
